Guam Community College Nursing & Allied Health Department License Practical Nursing- Quarterly Report April to June 2018

- 1. The Practical Nursing program is still on a hiatus pending review and approval from the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners. The faculty and administration of the program have worked diligently on updating the curriculum. On May 21, 2018, the revised Practical Nursing program document was approved through GCC's internal curriculum process. All relevant courses were also updated during this reporting period. The College submitted its Annual Report (June 1, 2017-June 30, 2018) to the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners on June 24, 2018.
- 2. The faculty and administration have been working closely with the recent graduates of the program and continue to encourage them to take the NCLEX-PN exam. As of June 30, 2018, twelve students from the 2017 graduates have taken the NCLEX-PN exam and all twelve students passed on their first attempt, making our current pass rate at 100%. This is a significant improvement as compared to 71% from the 2016 cohort. We are confident in the success of the remaining students who will be taking the exam later this year, and we will continue to support them.
- 3. The Nursing & Allied Health Department continues its efforts to contact students from previous cohorts who have not taken the NCELX-PN exam to find out who we can assist them to be better prepared. We also update our records on employment and educational status, as well as industry affiliations.
