- 1) The Nursing and Allied Health Department has voluntarily withdrawn its current Certificate in Practical Nursing program. This withdrawal became effective September 13, 2018 with the approval of the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners (GBNE). The department is now pursuing the development of an **Associate of Science Degree in Practical Nursing**.
- 2) The current pass rate for our 2017 Practical Nursing cohort is 74%. Sixteen out of nineteen graduates tested and passed the NCLEX-PN exam on their first try. We anticipate our final two graduates will test within the next few months. We congratulate all of our graduates on the successful completion of the program and we continue to reach out to our former graduates to support and encourage them to become licensed LPN's.
- 3) The department is continuing its practice to reach out to our graduates to determine their preparedness and planning for the NCLEX-PN, examination dates, employment or relocation status and intended continuing education plans.
