2020 ASPN COHORT

- Three out of 19 graduates have officially passed the NCLEX-PN and are now licensed practical nurses confirmed through the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners. The remaining 16 graduates are currently scheduling their exam dates and will be testing within the next few months.
- The Department continues to work closely with our ASPN graduates regarding their preparations for PN licensure. Online preparatory resources have been purchased through the generosity of the Takecare grant to assist our graduates with their studies for the NCLEX-PN exam and licensure. It is our goal to prepare all of our graduates to take their exam and be licensed within the next four months.
